

APPLY FOR VISA

During the Covid-19 pandemic, Indonesia welcomes all foreign nationals to enter Indonesia with sufficient travel documents, those are:

1. Diplomatic passport or service passport with visa issued by Indonesian Ministry of Foreign Affairs;
2. Regular passport with visa issued by Indonesian Immigration Bureau;

A. The mechanism for diplomatic or service passport holders to obtain a service Visa as follow:

1. The applicants visit the Indonesian Embassy and submit the following documents:
 - invitation/sponsorship letter of the IAWP conference (for sponsor letter, you can contact Superintendent Wingter Fauzi Kura/ Protocol Officer through mobile phone/WhatsApp +628125720295 or email secretariatiawp2020@gmail.com);
 - passport, expiring date not less than 6 (six) months;
 - covid-19 vaccination certificates (full dose);
 - result of the last PCR.
 - The process will take 5 (five) working days;
 - Kindly send all the copy to e-mail: wingter2019@gmail.com;
2. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia will authorize Indonesian Embassies abroad to issue visas to applicants.

B. The mechanism for regular passport holders (non-diplomatic/non-service passport) to obtain a visa is as follow:

1. The applicants contact the IAWP Protocol Committee (Superintendent Wingter Fauzi Kura/Protocol Officer through mobile phone/WhatsApp +628125720295 or email wingter2019@gmail.com) and submit the following documents:
 - visa application
 - a copy of the passport with expiring date not less than 6 (six) month;
 - a copy of passport page with stamp of last visited country in last 6 (six) months;
 - a copy of full dose Covid-19 vaccination certificate;
 - result of the last PCR Covid-19 test;
 - ticket itinerary;
 - photo 4x6 cm;
 - Pay the visa fee of USD 50 and an administration fee of IDR 200,000.

The process will take 5 (five) working days
